Climate scientists warned us twenty years ago that insect infestations would be greater on a warmer planet. This attack is 20 times larger than anything known. Beetle attack and forest fires wipe out tremendous swaths of forests regularly. The difference this time is that 80 million acres have been attacked.

You will search for red forests with our climate guide Bruce Melton PE in a modified four-wheel drive suburban or if you like, in an RV. From the Suburban, we can look from above on some of the finest four-wheel drive roads in North America. From the RV, we camp in style. We also offer motel excursions. Want to visit Yellowstone, Grand Teton or Rocky Mountain National Park? The beetles are everywhere from the four corners area to the Yukon in Canada.

Camp will be anywhere we want in a national forest, or state or national park. Want to camp above treeline at 12,000 feet, or in the middle of Yellowstone or Rocky Mountain National Park? How about a camp in the Grand Canyon, Mesa Verde or Dinosaur National Monument?
